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Recommended Practice – Diamond Grading in terms of Colour

In order to harmonise a trade practice that is followed internationally and in South Africa relating to small, uncertified parcel goods - generally up to 29 pointers, the Jewellery Council of SA has resolved to recommend that members follow the colour classification of the Rapaport Diamond Report as follows:

That Members apply a two-colour break, except for the higher colour bracket. They are as follows:


D – F
G – H
I – J
K – L
M – N

It is important that the jeweller assumes the responsibility to implement this practice with their suppliers.

These recommendations will be applied and supported by this Council should a dispute arise.

The motivation of this recommendation is to support and maintain consumer confidence in the products our members sell and to harmonise and codify industry practices across the diamond and jewellery industries.
